The Joppa cement plant is located in Illinois and was constructed in 1963. The plant supplies cement along the Ohio and Mississippi Rivers from Minneapolis to the Gulf of Mexico and as far east as Pittsburgh. Joppa Plant produces the highest quality oil well cements in the market.

- 62 employees
- 500,000 metric tons of cement produced annually

The Joppa facility utilizes tires as part of the plant Alternative Fuels program. It also operates a Selective Catalytic Reducer (SCR) to help control emissions. Other environmental sustainability initiatives include:

- Participating in controlled burns by the Illinois Department of Natural Resources to manage the natural area in Southern Illinois
- Contributing to Kentucky Waterways Alliance for Pocketbook mussels
